They then had to work in pairs to design and make a model construction vehicle using certain criteria. All the children worked incredibly hard and made excellent models and a particular well done needs to go to Atticus Roberts-Jones and Ted Simpson who won the competition and will go onto represent the school at the final in June.

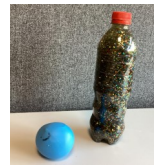


Wellbeing day
