- Sharing stories with children from another year group**, fostering friendships and a love of reading.

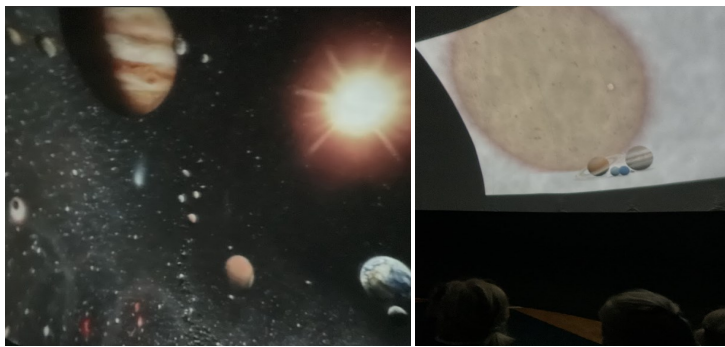

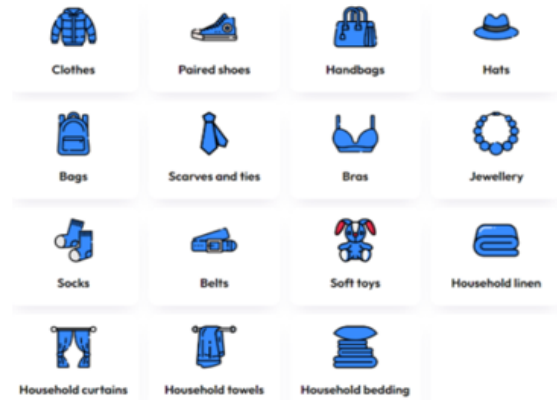
On Tuesday 11<sup>th</sup> March we will be holding a Bag2School event. Below is a list of items that will be collected. Please do not include any uniform items.
