Spring Term update from the Governors

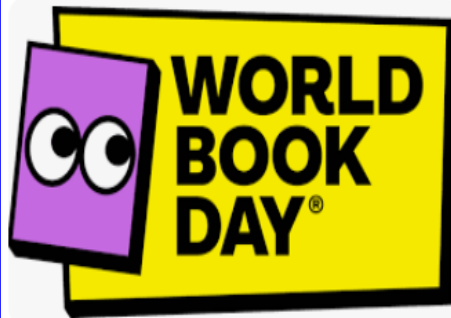
This term we have held a Full Governing Board (FGB) meeting and a Resources Committee meeting, with another FGB planned for just after the Easter holidays to approve the annual budget. Governors have also carried out monitoring visits this term. Our Safeguarding governor has been in for two safeguarding meetings to look at different aspects of the school's policies and procedures, and to speak with pupils about safeguarding. Another visit this term has looked at the quality of provision for pupils with SEND. We have also been in to look at reading and the impact of the school's work to further develop reading for pleasure; it was wonderful to hear the children talk so enthusiastically about reading and how they enjoy reading lessons at school. World Book Day this year was another successful event and the quality of the children's competition entries were impressive.

As governors we greatly appreciate the continuing support you as parents give our school, from ensuring your children attend regularly to supporting your child's learning and engaging in school events. When governors visit it's always a pleasure to speak to parents and see the children at work and play.
